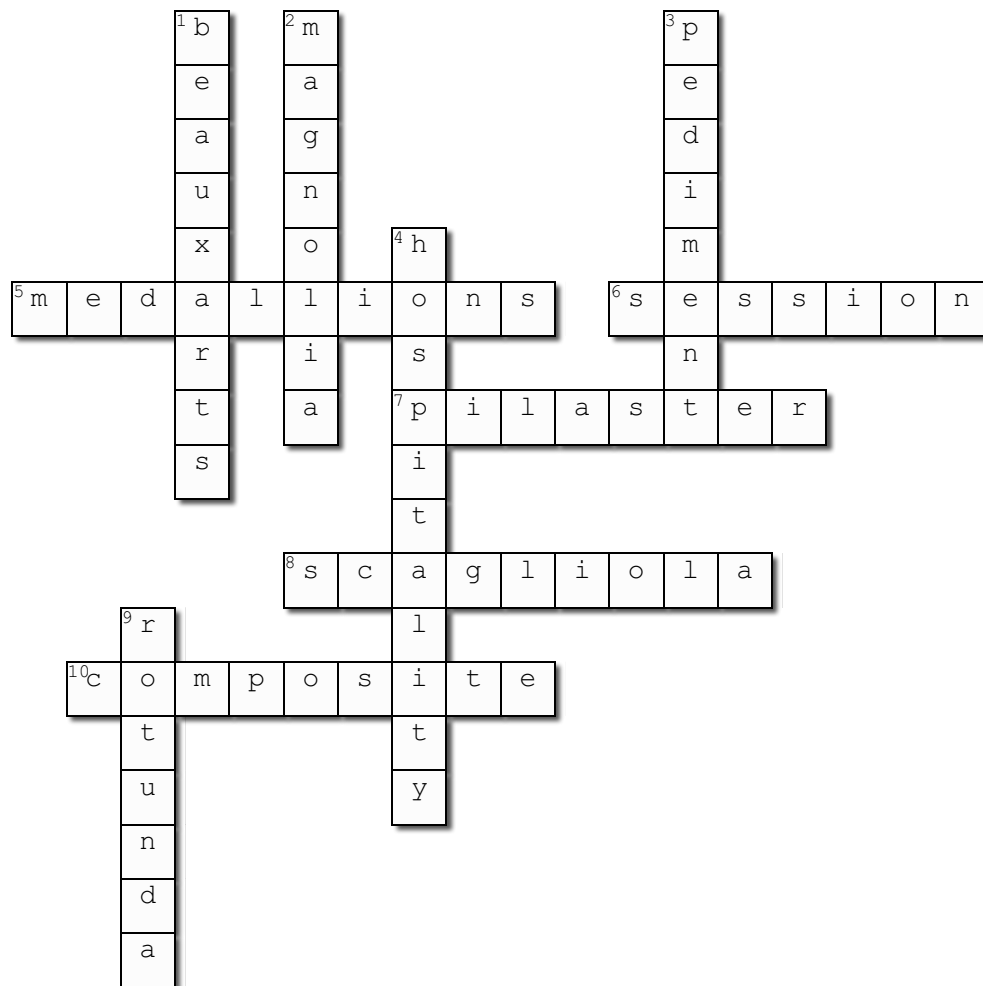


Mississippi State Capitol Crossword

8. The Capitol has eight different kinds of imitation marble with cracks in it called what? (**scagliola**)
10. An order of architecture of a column that is a cross between Ionic and Corinthian orders. (**composite**)
